ORDER:

In the Government Order second read above, District Climate Change Missions have been set up in every District in the State, to strengthen the climate response of the Government at the grass-root level with the District Collector as the Chairman and the District Forest Officer as the District Climate Officer.

In the letter third read above, the Mission Director, Tamil Nadu Climate Change Mission and the Department of Environment and Climate Change has stated that an amount of Rs.38.00 lakhs have been allocated for 38 Districts at Rs.1.00 lakhs per district for conducting capacity building workshop on prioritizing adaptation and mitigation to enhance development planning in districts which require immediate attention to Climate Change vulnerability, highlighting scientific evidence on Climate Change at Regional and Global arenas. Workshop will also be focusing on successful indigenous and technological interventions for community, eco-friendly adaptation for

building resilience in the society for local communities and Government line Departments. The Mission Director has further stated that the programme schedule, expert list and topics received from the Centre for Climate Change and Disaster Management, Anna University may be communicated to the District Mission Director, Convenor / District Climate Officer for conducting the above said Stakeholders workshops in coordination with the Mission Director, Tamil Nadu Climate Change Mission / Department of Environment and Climate Change.

The Mission Director, Tamil Nadu Climate Change Mission / Department of Environment and Climate Change has therefore requested to accord permission to release the fund to the District Climate Change Mission of the following 24 Districts at Rs.1.00 lakh per District, for conducting the Stakeholders Workshops on integrating climate change adaptation and mitigation to enhance development planning :-
