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ORDER :

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued for implementation of the "Tamil Nadu Wetlands Mission" for a period of five years from 2021-2022 to 2025-2026 for an amount of Rs.115.15 crore for ecological restoration of 100 wetlands in the period of five years with focus on livelihood.

2. In the letter second read above, the Member Secretary, Tamil Nadu State Wetland Authority submitted a proposal to revise the Government Order first read above without any deviation in overall financial allocation by according the necessary administrative sanction for the financial year 2024-2025 to 2026-2027 and financial allocation for 2024-2025, towards effective implementation of the Tamil Nadu Wetlands Mission during the years 2023-2024 to 2026-2027. Out of Rs.115.15 crore earmarked for this mission (Rs.101.59 crore (88.23%) for core activities and Rs.13.56 crore (11.78%) for non-core activities), Rs.14.76 crore provided for 2021- 2022 and 2022-2023 had already been allocated. The Member Secretary, Tamil Nadu State Wetland Authority has now proposed to revise the ratio of Core and Non-core activities in the ratio of 75% to core activity : 25% to non-core activity for the years 2024-2025 – 2026-2027 and requested necessary orders from the Government on the above lines.

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3. After careful examination, the Government accord administrative sanction for Rs.26,60,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty six crore and sixty lakh only) [Rs 22.04 crore for Core Activities and Rs.4.56 crore for Non-core activities] for implementation of Tamil Nadu Wetlands Mission during 2024-2025 to 2026-2027 and Financial sanction for Rs.4,25,00,000/- (Rupees Four crore twenty five lakh only) (Rs.2.20 crore for Core Activities and Rs.2.05 crore for Non-core activities) for the year 2024-2025 for the following components :-

5. Necessary additional funds of Rs.4,25,00,000/- will be provided in RE / FMA 2024-2025. Pending provision of such funds, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Member Secretary, Tamil Nadu State Wetlands Authority is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in

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para 3 above. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2024-2025. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Member Secretary, Tamil Nadu State Wetlands Authority is also directed to include this item of expenditure while sending the proposal for RE / FMA 2024-2025 and also send draft explanatory note for inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2024-2025 to Government in Finance (ECC&F/BG-I) Department without fail.

6. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O No.1411/2024, dated 09.10.2024 and ASL No.1068 (One thousand and sixty eight) (IFHRMS ASL No.2024101068).




